


	Grease all bearings and pivot points, including PTO shaft sliding members.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	IMPLEMENT, TRACTOR COMPATIBILITY Check implement and drive shaft do not foul anywhere in operation and drive shaft length is correct. Front End Loader: Ensure sub-frame and loader are correctly attached.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	ADJUSTMENTS Check clutch (if fitted) is correctly set and Vee belts correctly tensioned. Note: Further adjustment will be required after a short period of work. Familiarise operator with how to safely make all other adjustments required for correct operation.	<input type="checkbox"/>
